- 6 p.m. Guest judges begin judging cakes. Judges will choose 1st and 2nd place cakes from each category and one Best of Show.
- The 1st place and 2nd Place Winners and the Best of Show cakes will be auctioned off at the "live auction". The remaining entries will be automatically entered into the silent auction.
- Live Auction: The live auction consists of auctioning off the cakes one by one by an auctioneer. Each family will be given a numbered auction card for bidding. If you wish to bid, just hold the card up when the cake you want is being auctioned and the auctioneer will acknowledge your number. When the auctioneer believes
- and the auctioneer will acknowledge your number. When the auctioneer believes he's reached the highest bid, he'll award the cake to the winner. That's it!
 Silent Auction: Immediately after the initial cake judging, the remaining cakes will be entered into the silent auction. Each silent auction cake will have an associated bid sheet. If you find a cake you wish to bid on, just sign your number
 - and your bid amount on the sheet. Your bid amount must be higher than the previous bid. Minimum bids will be \$1 increments. All cakes will have an opening bid of \$5 assigned to get things started. The highest bidder wins!
